- 1. Having been mandated by Republic Act No. 9155 otherwise known as the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001, the Department of Education (DepEd) continuously conducts education research studies that serve as bases for necessary reforms and development.
- 2. DepEd has recently launched Sulong Edukalidad, a national campaign that aims to consolidate the efforts of all stakeholders to raise the quality of basic education in the country.
- 3. Moreover, DepEd continuously improves its programs and policies by advocating for strengthened evidence-based decision-making. In this connection, DepEd continues its conduct of **Research O'clock** from February to November 2020 at the *Bulwagan ng Karunungan*, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City. The specific schedules, themes, and indicative topics are provided in the enclosure.
- 4. This forum primarily seeks to promote the use of research results and evidence in decision-making, program designing and implementation, plan formulation, and adjustment. Specifically, it aims to

a. provide a venue for DepEd offices to learn from research studies from different sectors and organizations; and

- b. promote open discussions and continuous learning experiences for education leaders, researchers, policy makers, and educators in the basic education sector.
- 5. Selected research studies from the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) facility and studies conducted by partner organizations (e.g., research institutions and academe) will be presented. After each research presentation, a policy dialogue will be conducted to gather more insights about addressing education issues and concerns that emerge from the laid presentation.
