

The Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), in partnership with the Confucius Institute at the Angeles University Foundation (CI-AUF), has been implementing the Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL)-Chinese Mandarin since 2011. To date, there are 93 schools in 11 regions across the nation offering the program with over 300 trained teachers.

To develop the capacity of teachers in teaching the Chinese Mandarin language and culture, Summer Training Courses for the teachers of Batches 8, 9, and 10 shall be conducted on April 13 to May 8, 2020 at the CI-AUF.

Travel expenses and per diems shall be charged against MOOE funds, subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

MANDARIN TEACHERS (BATCH 8, 9 and 10)**


Greetings of prosperity from the Confucius Institute at AUF!
