CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE 2021 UNESCO PRIZE  
FOR GIRLS' AND WOMEN'S EDUCATION

The Philippine National Commission for UNESCO announces the Call for Nominations for the 2021 UNESCO Prize for Girls' and Women's Education.

The Prize contributes to two Sustainable Development Goals: Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all (Goal 4), and Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls (Goal 5).

Funded by the Government of the People's Republic of China, the Prize is conferred annually to two laureates, and it consists of an award of US \$50,000 each to help further their work in the area of girls' and women's education.

The online nominations must be submitted by UNESCO Permanent Delegations, in consultation with the Philippine Commission for UNESCO or NGOs in official partnership with UNESCO on May 26, 2021 (Midnight, Paris Time). Self-nominations are not accepted.
