2021 GLOBAL STUDENT PRIZE OF THE VARKEY FOUNDATION

The Varkey Foundation has launched the Chegg.org Global Student Prize (GSP) this year, a US\$50,000 sister award to the Global Teacher Prize (GTP).

The activity aims to highlight the efforts of extraordinary students throughout the world that are making a real impact on learning, the lives of their peers and on society beyond.

Chegg.org is the impact, advocacy, and research arm of Chegg: addressing the issues facing the modern student.

The Chegg.org GSP is open to all students who are at least 16 years old and enrolled in an academic institution or training and skills program. Part time students, as well as students enrolled in online courses are also eligible for the prize. The prize is open to students in every kind of school and, subject to local laws, in every country in the world.

Applicants for the Chegg.org GSP will be judged on a rigorous set of criteria to identify extraordinary students throughout the world. The academy will look for evidence of a combination of some or all of the criteria below.

1. Academic achievement
2. Impact on the peers
3. Making a difference in the community and beyond
4. Overcoming the odds
5. Creativity and innovation
6. Fostering global citizens

The winner will be chosen by the GSP Academy made up of prominent individuals from both inside and outside education. They include educational experts, artists, scientists, sports people, public officials, tech entrepreneurs, company directors, and journalists and commentators from around the world.
