This Bid Bulletin is hereby issued for the information and guidance of all prospective bidders and shall form an integral part of the bidding documents issued earlier for the above project.

I. Section I. Invitation to Bid

- a. Item No. 1, pages 7-8 of the bidding documents, is hereby amended to read:

The **Department of Education (DepEd)**, through the *Government of the Philippines (GOP) under Learner Support Program Current Funds (FY 2021)*, intends to apply the sum of **Philippine Pesos Twenty-One Million, Seven Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Four Hundred Ninety-Two and 49/100 (Php 21,786,492.49)**, being the ABC to payments under the contract for **Procurement of Hauling Services for the Delivery of Health Care Supplies to Schools Division Offices, broken down as follows:**

b. Item No. 2, page 8 of the bidding documents, is hereby amended to read:

Prospective bidders should have completed, within a period of **five (5) years** immediately preceding the deadline for submission of bids at least two (2) similar contracts and the total of the aggregated contract amount should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC; and the largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the ABC.

c. Item No. 7, page 9 of the bidding documents, is hereby amended to read:

Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **10:00 A.M. of July 23, 2021 at Bulwagan ng Karunungan, Ground Floor, Rizal Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Ave., Pasig City.**

Late bids shall not be accepted.

d. Item No. 9, page 9 of the bidding documents, is hereby amended to read:

Bid opening shall be on **July 23, 2021, 10:00 A.M. at Bulwagan ng Karunungan, Ground Floor, Rizal Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Ave., Pasig City.** Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

For the purpose of constituting a quorum, both the physical and virtual presence of the BAC and TWG members shall be considered pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 09-2020.

II. Section II. Instruction to Bidders

a. ITB Clause 2.1, page 12 of the bidding documents, is hereby amended to read:

The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for GAA 2021 in the amount of **Philippine Pesos Twenty-One Million, Seven Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Four Hundred Ninety-Two and 49/100 (Php 21,786,492.49) only.**

b. ITB Clause 5.3, page 13 of the bidding documents, is hereby amended to read:

Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have completed **at least two (2) similar contracts**, the aggregate amount of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be fifty percent (50%) of the ABC for each of the lots and the largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least half of the percentage of the ABC as required above (i.e. 25% of the ABC).

III. Section III. Bid Data Sheet

- a. ITB Clause 5.3, page 19 of the bidding documents, is hereby amended to read:

For the purpose of the track-record requirement, contracts similar to the Project shall refer to **Hauling and Delivery Services**.

For this purpose, the similar contract should have been completed within a period of **five (5) years** immediately preceding the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.

Complete delivery shall be made within the contract duration stipulated above, from the date of receipt of the NTP by supplier or as may be indicated thereon.


