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68 I. CALL TO ORDER

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70 The BAC I Chairperson, Usec. Alain Del B. Pascua, presided and called the
 71 pre-bid conference to order at 10:00 A.M. The BAC Secretariat documented
 72 the minutes of meeting.

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75 II. CERTIFICATION OF QUORUM

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77 The BAC I Chairperson certified that the quorum of the BAC was present to
 78 transact business. He acknowledged the presence of the BAC members, BAC
 79 Secretariat, Technical Working Group, end-user representative, observer and
 80 prospective bidders.

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82 III. HIGHLIGHTS OF DISCUSSION

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84 The BAC I Chairperson welcomed everyone to the pre-bid conference.

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86 The BAC I Chairperson asked Ms. Christa Nicolas, BAC Secretariat, to
 87 facilitate the roll of attendance. Moreover, the BAC I Chairperson
 88 announced that the floor was open to queries, information, proposals or
 89 other concerns coming from the prospective bidders or suppliers on the
 90 assumption that the prospective bidders have downloaded bidding
 91 documents from the PhilGEPS, requested from the BAC Secretariat for
 92 copies of the same, or bought copies of the same.

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94 Ms. Nicolas proceeded with the presentation of the project information
 95 such as the approved budget of the contract, end-user of the project, cost
 96 of bidding documents, observers invited and focused on the salient
 97 features of the Bidding Documents such as the bid data sheet, special
 98 conditions of contract, schedule of requirements, technical specifications,
 99 lumpsum bid price form and checklist of requirements.

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101 After the presentation, the BAC I Chairperson opened the floor for
 102 queries/clarifications, as follows:
