FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 08 day of October 2021 by and between:

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, located at DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City, Philippines, represented herein by its Secretary, **LEONOR MAGTOLIS BRIONES**, as per Department Order No. 023, s. 2021 (hereinafter referred to as "DEPED");

-And-

TRANSPAC CARGO LOGISTICS, INC., a duly registered entity existing under the laws of the Philippines with principal address at Ground Floor, Azucena Building, 255 National Road, Pamplona Tres, Las Pinas City Philippines, represented herein by its Authorized Representative, **SEAN WINFRED M. PALER**, (hereinafter referred to as "TRANSPAC").


WITNESSETH, that

WHEREAS, **DEPED** and **TRANSPAC** wish to enter into a framework agreement which will enable **DEPED**, from time to time, to enter into a Call-Off Contract or a series of Call-Off Contracts with **TRANSPAC** for some or all of the Services of the type described in the Framework Agreement List;


WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall apply to the Logistics Services to be provided by **TRANSPAC** under any Call-Off;

WHEREAS, this Agreement is for the option to procure the services determined to be necessary and desirable to address and satisfy the needs of **DEPED** but by its nature, use or characteristic, the quantity, frequency and/or exact time of need cannot be accurately pre-determined;

WHEREAS, **DEPED** has the option to procure the service items provided in the Framework Agreement List, attached and made an integral part of this Agreement, on a date and time to be determined in the Call-Off to be issued for such purpose by **DEPED**; and

WHEREAS, TRANSPAC, which passed the eligibility screening conducted by the DEPED, shall maintain and update the eligibility requirements during period of this Agreement and shall honor all obligations under this Framework Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, the parties hereby agree as follows:

**Article I
GENERAL CONDITIONS**

This Framework Agreement is an option contract. DEPED is given the option to either procure or not procure at all the items of services identified in the Framework Agreement List. The discretion to exercise the option falls solely with DEPED. TRANSPAC may not require or demand the procurement of any or all of the items of services in the Framework Agreement List.

In this Framework Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them under Republic Act No. 9184 and its revised IRR and the applicable Philippine Bidding Documents issued by the Government Procurement Policy Board. Unless the context indicates otherwise, the following shall have the following meanings:

- "Agreement" refers to this Framework Agreement, including and all other documents referred to;
- "Agreement Commencement Date" the date for commencement of this Agreement specified in the Notice to Proceed or Notice to Execute Framework Agreement;
- "Call-Off" a specific procurement request or order made by DEPED within the duration of the Framework Agreement exercising the option and requiring the Service Provider to deliver the Services agreed upon under the terms and conditions of Framework Agreement;
- "Charges" refers to the charges and the disbursements payable by DEPED, in consideration of the due performance of Services, as specified or calculated in accordance with this Agreement;
- "DEPED" refers to the Procuring Entity subject of this Framework Agreement;
- "Framework Agreement" refers to the written agreement between the DEPED and the Service Provider that identifies the terms and conditions under which specific purchases, otherwise known as "Call-



The Framework Agreement is in the nature of an option contract between the DEPED and the Service Provider granting DEPED the option to either place an order for any of the Services identified in the Framework Agreement List or not procure at all, within a minimum period of one (1) year to a maximum period of three (3) years;

refers to the list of Services, and their corresponding technical specifications, scope of work, projected quantities, and estimated prices, subject of the Framework Agreement.

refers to the winning bidder or the Third-party Logistics Service Provider.

"Service Provider Personnel"

all such person, including (without limitation) employees, officers, suppliers, sub-contractors and agents of the Service Provider as are engaged in the performance of any of the Logistics Services described under this Agreement;

“Warehousing Services”


all agreed Services of any nature whatsoever related to the storage, handling and stacking of goods, including but not limited to sorting, hauling, tagging, loading, unloading, stock management, preparation for delivery, provision of “Service Provider equipment, personnel and reports”, and all or any part of the Services to be provided to, or activities to be undertaken and completed for DEPED by the Service Provider under this Agreement (including any variations to such Services and/or activities as agreed by the Parties, save when DEPED may require amendment to the Services), and any functions or responsibilities which may be reasonably regarded as incidental to the foregoing Services or activities and which may be reasonably inferred from the Framework Agreement;

Article II DURATION

The term of this Agreement shall be effective from the date of issuance of the Notice to Execute a Framework Agreement until 30 June 2022, unless sooner revoked by both parties, rescinded by DEPED upon reaching the maximum threshold on liquidated damages or as allowed under the Guidelines for Contract Termination, or when the maximum quantities specified in the Framework Agreement List have been exhausted.

Article III CONSIDERATION

For the consideration of **ONE PESO (Php 1.00)**, the DEPED have the option to procure any or all of the items of services in the Framework Agreement List through

the issuance of Call-off and TRANSPAC commits to perform the services subject to the conditions of the Call-off.

**Article IV
PERFECTION OF PROCUREMENT CONTRACT**

The Framework Agreement being an option contract, a procurement contract is perfected only when the DEPED exercises the option to procure any item from the Framework Agreement List through the issuance of a Call-off.

The Framework Agreement List is attached hereto as "Annex A".

**Article V
OBLIGATION TO ANSWER A CALL-OFF**

Once the DEPED issues a Call-off, TRANSPAC is bound to perform the services identified at the same time and date specified in the Call-off.

Failure on the part of TRANSPAC to perform the services shall warrant forfeiture of performance security or performance securing declaration and imposition of liquidated damages as provided for in the Guidelines on use of Framework Agreement by all Procuring Entities without prejudice to all another applicable sanctions.

**Article VI
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

The terms and conditions of this Framework Agreement shall be governed by Guidelines on the Use of Framework Agreement by all Procuring Entity and all relevant issuance of the GPPB.


