VIRTUAL CLIMATE SCIENCE YOUTH CAMP

The Department of Science and Technology through the Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), in cooperation with the Marine Science Institute of the University of the Philippines (UP-MSI), will be conducting a Virtual Climate Science Youth Camp (VCSYC) from November 8 to 12, 2021.

This year's theme, "Finding Career Path Through Research," will showcase potential careers in the field of Marine Science through the UP-MSI's research project on harmful algal blooms (HABs).
