**SERIES OF ONLINE COMPETITIONS IN RELATION TO THE CELEBRATION
OF THE 2021 NATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS CONSCIOUSNESS WEEK**

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 9210 or the “National Human Rights Consciousness Week Act of 2002,” December 4 to 10 of every year is declared as the National Human Rights Consciousness Week in the Philippines.

The aforementioned law mandates all government agencies, including government-owned and controlled corporations to commemorate the event by conducting various simple and appropriate activities that shall raise awareness on basic human rights in relation to the services of their respective agencies.

In line with this year’s celebration, the Commission on Human Rights will hold a series of Online Competitions in relation to Human Rights for elementary and secondary learners, as well as college students.

Learning institutions, both public and private, are mandated to observe the human rights week and to cultivate a human rights culture that aims for sustainable development in the country, especially among students.

The event will also feature different activities such as human rights declamation contest, singing contest, human rights educators forum, spoken word poetry, and webinar on discrimination research.

The culminating event on December 10, 2021, will coincide with the anniversary day of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and is celebrated as International Human Rights Day.
