2021 ONLINE NATIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID), will conduct the **2021 Online National Festival of Talents (NFOT)** with the theme, Demonstrating Resiliency of Learners During the COVID-19 Pandemic Through Showcasing of Skills and Talents, via DepEd Philippines FB Live Stream **from January 24 to 28, 2022**.
2. NFOT aims to provide an opportunity for learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools, including the Alternative Learning System (ALS), to showcase their skills and talents in different disciplines. It also serves as a platform for assessing learners' artistic abilities, language, scientific, technological and livelihood skills, critical analysis for deep reasoning, among other abilities which are set in the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum, and for making meaning out of their experiences.
3. The 2021 NFOT will be conducted through a **Virtual Showcase** by repackaging the different events in this Festival to make it more responsive and relevant to the present situation. This is also to ensure the strict compliance of health and safety protocols set by Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF).

General Guidelines for the 2021 Online National Festival of Talents

1. The theme for this year's Online National Festival of Talents shall be ***"Demonstrating Resiliency of Learners During the Covid 19 Pandemic through Showcasing of Skills and Talents"*** via DepEd Philippines FB Live Stream on **January 24-28, 2022**.
2. The 2021 NFOT shall showcase talents and skills of learners in all or any of the following areas:
 - 2.1 Cookery for Technolympics;
 - 2.2 Likhawitang Tanghal and Dance for Sining Tanghalan;
 - 2.3 Pinaghandayang Talumpati for Pambansang Tagisan ng Talento;
 - 2.4 Speech Exhibition for the Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL)
 - 2.5 Oratorical Speech for Population Development;
 - 2.6 Arabic Reading for Musabaqah;
 - 2.7 Visual and Performing Arts for Learners with Disabilities (LWDs); and
 - 2.8 STEMazing for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics.
3. Learners and teacher-coaches who shall participate in the showcase of talents and skills will receive a certificate of participation and recognition from the Bureau of Learning Delivery – Student Inclusion Division.
4. The participation of the region is **not compulsory**. However, the regional office is given the option to decide on which events they can participate in. There shall be one (1) entry for each event.
5. The recorded feedback from the experts shall be given after all presentations in each event for learners and teachers to gain insights for further improvement.
6. The regional presentations must adhere to the existing Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases protocols; child protection and other related policies. Consent must be sought from the parents or guardians of the learner/participants for the airing of the 2021 NFOT on FB live.
7. Each regional entry should have a **minimum of two (2) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes Audio-Visual Presentation (AVP)** in every event including the introduction of each learner: **name of the learner, grade level, school, division, and region**. Filming of the entry may be done by the coach, learner, and parent following the health and safety protocols. Maximize the use of technology and editing software to produce the presentation. There shall be a separate two-minute recorded AVP of the Regional Director to introduce the entire regional entries.

8. The material should be in high definition **1280 x 720 30 fps** video format or a video of good broadcasting quality in **MP4 format**. Follow the sample file name: **Event_Region_2021NFOT** (e.g. Technolympics_RegionXI_2021 NFOT). Official entries must be endorsed by the Regional Director to **Leila P. Areola**, Director IV, BLD.

9. Deadline for submission of Regional entries is **on or before December 10, 2021 (Friday)** through this email address: nfot.bldsid@deped.gov.ph.

(A Showcase of Marketable Products and Performances)



COMPONENT AREA	HOME ECONOMICS
GRADE LEVEL	Junior & Senior High School including ALS
EVENT PACKAGE	COOKERY (COoking VIDEO)
NO. OF PARTICIPANTS	One (1)
TIME ALLOTMENT	Following the standard number of hours in preparing the dish. For the video Presentation maximum of five (5) minutes.
DESCRIPTION	Applying the principles in Cookery NC II based on the Curriculum Guide. The task includes preparation of a SINGLE MENU (Meat/ Seafood/ Vegetable).

I. Event Rules and Mechanics

- A. The showcase is open to all learners who are officially enrolled in Junior and Senior High School including ALS.
- B. Participants must consist of one (1) learner and one (1) coach who will give minimal assistance to the learner.
- C. Participant should wear PPE appropriate for cooking within the standard requirements.
- D. Event materials, supplies, tools, equipment, and other things needed in the activity shall be made ready before the shooting schedule.
- E. Learner may showcase the preparation and presentation of experimental or localized dish good for 1 serving following the performance standards:
 - 1. Safety
 - 2. Process
 - 3. Proper use of tools
 - 4. Palatability
 - 5. Presentation

6. Fluency of oral communication

F. Participants shall follow the sequence of cooking video showcase as stated below

1. Presentation of participant's information (Name of Learner, Grade Level, School, Division and Region).
2. Introduction of the title of recipe, tools, equipment's, and ingredients to be used (use of MSG is not allowed, prevent branding)
3. Cooking proper (observing health and safety protocol).
4. Presentation of food in a plate/platter or any packaging material that is appropriate.

G. The working area should be cleaned immediately after the activity.

H. The recipe shall be included in the video presentation.

I. The video will be recorded with the permission of the parents.

The **Speech Exhibition** is open to all nationally recognized and regionally initiated public schools offering any of the following languages: Spanish, Japanese, German, French, Korean and Chinese-Mandarin. The **SPFL** performers will showcase the said speech exhibition as the official event for 2021.

EVENT	Speech Exhibition
NO. OF CONTESTANT/S	One (1) language in every region
TIME ALLOTMENT	3 minutes pre-recorded performance
DESCRIPTION	SPFL Speech Exhibition showcases talents in writing and delivering an online speech in a foreign language. The participants of this event are Grades 7-10 students
Performance Standard	The learner demonstrates understanding of the language and culture through engagement in conversation, showcase of talents/skills using the foreign language and exchange of opinions, thoughts, and feelings in simple terms.

**EVENT RULES AND
MECHANICS**

1. Performers in the Speech Exhibition must be bona fide students of the nationally recognized and regionally initiated public schools of the Special Program in the Foreign Language (SPFL).
2. Each SPFL implementing region shall select only one foreign language to present.
3. Entries for this event shall be pre-recorded.
4. Performers shall record an originally written speech in the language being represented.
5. Performers shall wear formal attire.

2021 Musabaqah Skills Exhibition

(A Showcase of Talents and Skills in Arabic Language and Islamic Values)



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1. The 2021 National Musabaqah Skills Exhibition aims to provide the Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) learners with opportunities to showcase their skills and talents through exhibitions of their performance.
2. The National Musabaqah Skills Exhibition is focused on the category: Arabic Reading using Qur'an.
3. The Musabaqah showcasing of skills and talents is open to all learners attending ALIVE classes in the Public/Private Madaris/schools.

GRADE LEVEL	Any grade level within the age bracket (Nine to twelve – 9 to 12 years old)
EVENT PACKAGE	Arabic Reading
NO. OF PARTICIPANT/ REPRESENTATIVE	One (1) Participant/Representative for Arabic Reading per Region
DESCRIPTION	This category will showcase the reading skills and developing good speech habits of Muslim learners. The Qur'an is the material to be used as it is an authentic source of stories and literature which is acceptable to all Muslims.
OBJECTIVES	The category aims to exhibit the proficient and advanced reading skills of ALIVE learners in Arabic Language, specifically, showcasing the literacy skills of the ALIVE learners to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • recite the verse (ayah) / chapter (surah) following the rules of Tajweed; • read the verse (ayah) / chapter (surah) with clear voice in tarteel; and • demonstrate the proper way to pause, continue and full stop in reading the verse with stage presence.

I. Mechanics

- 1.1 During the training, only the coach, participant, accompanied by the guardian should be present in the area. Social distancing and wearing of face mask and face shield must be observed.
- 1.2 Each region will have one (1) participant in the Arabic Reading category as a skill exhibition. The participants may either be male or female ALIVE learners, ages 9-12 years old.
- 1.3 The participant shall read the selected *Suwar/Surah* in Tarteel assigned to the region:

- 1.4 The participant should have a copy of the Holy Qur'an for reading.
- 1.5 The participant should wear proper attire (black abaya and white hijab/kombong for female and white tawb/kimon with taqiyah/totob/kopya for male).

- 1.6 The participant shall be seated on the floor with book stand and using a microphone in the actual reading of the selected Surah.
- 1.7 Reading of the selected *Surah* shall be done within five (5) minutes.
- 1.8 Certificates of Recognition and Participation will be awarded to all the participants and coaches.

1. Guidelines for identifying the Official Coaches:
 - a. he/she should be an alive teacher (permanent / cos); and
 - b. directly teach / train the contestant.

COMPONENT AREA	VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS
GRADE LEVEL	Grades 3-10
EVENT PACKAGE	Song and Dance Performance
NO. OF CONTESTANT	A group of not more than 5 learners and preferably in a school that has 2 or more classes with learners with disabilities.
TIME ALLOTMENT	5 minutes in maximum including 2 minutes' introduction and synthesis of the pre-recorded presentation.
DESCRIPTION	The event is an online based and will show case the regional culture through dance and song performance of learners with disabilities. The performance shall demonstrate love of one's culture.
PERFORMANCE STANDARD	Demonstrates understanding of salient features of Music and Arts of the Philippines and the world through appreciation, analysis and performance for self-development, celebration of Filipino cultural identity.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Each Region shall prepare one (1) song and dance presentation showing their culture or anything related with their region following the IATF protocol.
2. Presentation shall be performed by a group of not more than 5 learners and preferably in a school that has 2 or more classes with learners with disabilities. For group performance, it must have a caption stating that "No IATF Protocols have been violated".
3. The length of the presentation must be 5 minutes in maximum including 2 minutes' introduction and synthesis of the pre-recorded presentation.
4. The introduction must include a short description of the presentation -to mention the Region, the Schools Division and school where the LWDs come from. At the end of the presentation is a short synthesis, highlighting the culture/identity of the region.
5. The genre of the presentation is not restricted as long as it can show the creativity of the learners with disability.

NO. OF PARTICIPANTS	Individual or pair Each region may submit one video for any one of the scenarios.
TIME ALLOTMENT	Two (2) minutes
DESCRIPTION	<p>The showcase enables learners to apply science and mathematics thinking skills to solve problems that have local, national, and global impact. It allows the participants to become problem solvers by addressing social, scientific, and environmental issues through the application of 21st century skills.</p> <p>In the showcasing, the participants will be creating a 2-minute video presentation proposing a solution to a given scenario.</p>

MECHANICS	<p>For the video to be considered for showcasing in the National Festival of Talents it must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be original footage or student created animation or combination of both. • be maximum of 2 minutes in length (Including the credits) • accurately use scientific, technological, and engineering concept in presenting their solution. • not include any copyrighted material in presentation (i.e., music and images). • documented correctly/properly acknowledged all sources and relevant copyright law has been followed. • be filmed at home and follow existing IATF guidelines in effect in the respective locality. Participants who will be working in pairs must collaborate remotely. • be engaging, creative and have strong narrative. • target the public as the audience.
<p>Showcase Guidelines</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The video presentations will focus on the following scenarios/themes: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Natural Disasters (earthquakes, tsunami, volcanic eruption, typhoon, etc.) and Climate Change/Global Warming b. Agriculture and Food security c. Environment and Natural Resources d. Healthcare/Pandemics 2. Each region may submit one video per scenario/theme. 3. The participants may use the internet and other printed resources in developing their video presentation provided relevant provisions of the copyright law are followed. 4. The video presentations may consist of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Plan of action that may be done on local or global scale to address the challenges set in the scenario. b. Detail key features of the proposed solution. c. Challenges to resolve to effectively implement the proposed solution. d. Proposed solution maybe similar or different from existing practices, technologies, and solutions. If so, the video presentation shall include on how the proposed solution would build up from the existing practices, technology, and solutions.
