2022 SEAMEO-JAPAN EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AWARD

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO) and the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan (MEXT), in cooperation with UNESCO Asia and Pacific Regional Bureau for Education, will conduct the 2022 SEAMEO-Japan Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) Award with the theme, “Education Transformation through Partnership.”

The 2022 SEAMEO-Japan ESD Award aims to:

1. Recognize multi-stakeholder partnerships as important vehicles for mobilizing and sharing knowledge, expertise, technologies, and financial resources to support the achievement of the sustainable development goals in Southeast Asia and Japan.
2. Encourage schools to create collaborative and coordinated systems for family and community engagement.
3. Ensure quality and equity education for all students through partnership efforts in developing effective teaching and learning approaches.

The SEAMEO Secretariat invites all public and private kindergarten, elementary, secondary, vocational, and technical (equivalent to Grade 12) schools in 11 SEAMEO Member Countries to participate by submitting a completed submission form and a three (3) minute video presenting the school initiative/program in MPEG-2 (MP4) format relating to the theme.
