The University of the Philippines Association of Civil Engineering Students (UP ACES) will host its 18th National Civil Engineering Summit (NCES), which includes the Bridge Building Competition (BBC) 2022: Project Bidding Edition.

Open to both high school and undergraduate students all over the Philippines, the competition aims to unleash negotiation and engineering instincts through the creation of project proposals and the utilization of digital software programs to fully envision how projects materialize.

For this year's Bridge Building Competition, only one category is available where both high school and college students are eligible to participate. Teams would consist of a maximum of three members and one adviser, and each school may only roster up to three teams. The participants are tasked to design a bridge of a certain type that closely emulates that of construction firm projects. Project proposals will be presented by the participants, as well as 2D and 3D CAD models. The project proposal contains the overview of the project, complete bridge details, materials, and cost estimates.

Registration starts from July 4 to July 27, 2022. The Awarding Ceremony, which will happen on September 24, 2022, marks the end of BBC and NCES honoring the winners and celebrating the efforts of all the participating teams. The ceremony will be live-streamed on the official page of UP ACES and it will also feature inspirational talks.
