#### CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO THE ASEAN-MAYBANK SCHOLARSHIP 2024

The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN), in collaboration with the Maybank Foundation, is calling for applications to the ASEAN-Maybank Scholarship for the Calendar Year 2024.

The program will provide support to students from all ASEAN Member States to pursue their undergraduate studies outside their home countries but within ASEAN.

The application is open to deserving ASEAN nationals to pursue their Bachelor's Degree at prestigious universities in the ASEAN region.

In the Basic Education sector of the Philippines, senior high school students preparing for tertiary education are eligible to apply, provided they have the following qualifications:

1. A citizen of any of the 10 ASEAN Member States,
2. Possess excellent academic qualifications and is active in extracurricular activities,
3. Graduated with a pre-university study (graduating Grade 12 students) with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 or equivalent in the Philippines,
4. The prospective field of study/degree is listed among the approved disciplines of the program, and
5. Received an admission letter or letter of offer from a university outside the Philippines that is within the ASEAN University Network membership.

Eligible candidates will then be shortlisted and interviewed prior to the final selection. After graduating, scholars are required to serve a three-year bond either at Maybank, the ASEAN Secretariat, or the ASEAN Foundation.

The submission of applications for the ASEAN-Maybank Scholarship should not be later than March 15, 2024. Interested applicants may access the link: <https://forms.gle/qm6T6xeo4i5ZhBVF6> for updates and additional information.
