### LEASE CONTRACT

**DEPED** and **OTUS** are collectively called "PARTIES."

WHEREAS, DEPED invited bids for the lease of photocopying machines, and received bids from two (2) bidders; DEPED opened, read, and evaluated the bids of the two (2) bidders and declared OTUS as having the Lowest Calculated Bid for the project; after evaluation, DEPED post-qualified and declared the bid of OTUS as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid in the sum of PHILIPPINE PESOS TWO MILLION ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND, FORTY-EIGHT and 40/100 (PhP2,185,048.40) ONLY, (hereinafter called the "Contract Price") detailed as follows:

### NOW THIS CONTRACT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- In this Contract, words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
- The following documents as required by the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Contract, viz:
  - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBD);
    - i. Invitation to Bid;
    - ii. Instruction to Bidders;
    - iii. Bid Data Sheet;
    - iv. General and Special Conditions of the Contract;
    - v. Schedule of Requirements;
    - vi. Technical Specifications; and
    - vii. Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated 13 December 2022.
  - b. **OTUS'** bid, including the Eligibility Requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

c. Performance Security;

d. Notice of Award of Contract and OTUS' conforme thereto; and

- e. Other contract documents required by existing laws and/or DepEd in the PBD. OTUS agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Order, and Warranty Security, shall form part of the Contract.
- 3. OTUS shall post a Performance Security within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award in the form and amount prescribed therein. The performance security shall be posted in favor of DEPED, and shall be forfeited in the event it is established that OTUS is in default of any of its obligations under this contract. OTUS shall be responsible for the extension of its performance security and/or undertake to renew its performance security whenever necessary, and without need of prior notice or instruction from the DEPED, to ensure that it is in force and effect for the whole duration of the contract and until a Certificate of Final Acceptance is duly issued.
- 4. OTUS shall render services for a period of ONE (1) YEAR or based on the volume or number of copies as indicated during the award of the contract (2,299,992 black and white copies, and 8 colored copies), whichever comes first, which shall commence within 15 WORKING DAYS upon OTUS' receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP) or as may be indicated in the NTP, in coordination with the Administrative Service-Asset Management Division. OTUS shall ensure that the services will be rendered in accordance with the Schedule of Requirements, which is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof.
- 5. OTUS shall render services at the DepEd Central Office, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City. Services rendered at sites other than the DepEd Central Office without DEPED's written authorization and/or approval may be rejected by the latter. Violation of this provision, based on documents and reports submitted and validated by the authorized receiving personnel may be cause for the termination of the Contract.
- 6. The services to be rendered by OTUS must conform to and comply with the standards mentioned in Section VI. Schedule of Requirements of the Bidding Documents, and the photocopying machines must be in accordance with the final technical specifications as approved by the Bids and Awards Committee based on the actual offer (demonstration unit) of OTUS and reflected in the post-qualification report, which is hereto attached as Annex "C" and made an integral part hereof.

Any proposal by **OTUS** to deliver photocopying machines of different technical specifications, in lieu of those of the approved bids or samples, shall not be allowed. However, under justifiable circumstances, i.e. fortuitous events, force majeure, acts of God, public state emergency, or those defined under the Civil Code and other similar circumstances, delivery of goods of equivalent, higher or superior technical specifications may be permitted, subject to the evaluation and favorable recommendation of the **DEPED's** end-user or implementing unit, and the approval of the herein authorized signatory. In any such case, the proposal by **OTUS** for substitution shall be in writing and shall not result in any additional cost or undue burden to **DEPED**.

- 7. In case OTUS encounters condition(s) impeding timely completion of services, OTUS shall promptly notify DEPED in writing within five (5) calendar days from notice of such condition(s). Any request for work suspension and/or contract period extension shall be promptly done in writing as soon as circumtances for such request have become apparent. OTUS must provide sufficient proof to support any request for work suspension and/or contract period extension.
- 8. The Contract Price shall be paid to **OTUS** in accordance with the following disbursement procedures:
  - a. OTUS may submit a request for payment based on the following:
    - Cumulative value of actual combined reading for printing and copying of all machines based on the schedule of services and other relevant terms and conditions of the Contract; and,
    - ii. Certification by **OTUS**, as approved by the duly authorized DepEd representative, that the services have been rendered in accordance with the Contract.

Other documents in support of a request for payment may be required by **DEPED** pursuant to existing disbursement, accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

- b. Payment shall be made to OTUS within sixty (60) days from submission of the documents specified in SCC Clause 2.2 and other documents as may be prescribed by DEPED in the following manner:
  - Payment shall be made to **OTUS** on a monthly basis based on the actual combined reading for printing and copying of all machines;
  - ii. Total billing charge shall be computed by multiplying the actual total number of copies reproduced less 2% spoilage and test copies by the rental rate. As payment is based on the cost of the actual number of copies reproduced, total payment may be slightly lower than the amount of the contract award;
  - iii. One percent (1%) of the total monthly billing shall be deducted for every violation committed by **OTUS** in the terms and conditions of this Contract.
- 9. OTUS shall ensure compliance with the functionality requirements of the machines and ensure any replacements or repair in case of defects or technical problems during the lease period. The replacement of toners, drums, fusers or imaging unit can be easily done by the end-user without technical intervention, if necessary. OTUS must have at least one (1) on-call technician to repair defective machine and response time shall be within two (2) hours from oral or written notifications. OTUS must also ensure that there are 65 working units at all times in the DepEd Central Office.
- 10. **OTUS** shall be liable for liquidated damages in an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion, for every day of delay. **DEPED** shall deduct the liquidated damages from any

money due or which may become due to OTUS, or collect from any of the securities posted by OTUS, whichever is convenient to DEPED. Once the acccumulated amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the Contract Price, **DEPED** may rescind or terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.

11. The PARTIES shall make every effort to resolve amicably and by mutual consultation any and all disputes or differences arising between the **PARTIES** in connection with the implementation of the Contract. Should such dispute not be resolved amicably, it shall be submitted to Early Neutral Evaluation pursuant to R.A. No. 9285, or the "Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004," and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.
