CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT made and entered into this 6th day of July 2023 by and between the **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION**, located at DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City, Philippines, represented herein by its Undersecretary for Human Resource and Organizational Development, **GLORIA JUMAMIL-MERCADO**, as per Department Order No. 001, s. 2023 and Office Order OO-OSEC-2023-060 (hereinafter referred to as “**DEPED**”); and **JONECO TECH MARKETING CORPORATION**, represented herein by its Account Manager, **VICENTE E. ESPERANZA III**, with office address at No. 7 Pioneer St. cor. Sheridan St., Elena Roces Compound, Highway Hills, Mandaluyong City, Philippines (hereinafter referred to as “**JONECO**”), as per Secretary’s Certificate dated 21 January 2023 (hereto attached as Annex “A”).

DEPED and **JONECO** are collectively called “**PARTIES.**”

WHEREAS, DEPED invited bids for the procurement of laptop as assistive electronic tool for learners with disabilities consisting of one (1) lot, and received bids from eight (8) bidders; **DEPED** opened, read, and evaluated the bids of the eight (8) bidders and declared the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) for Lot No. 1; after evaluation, **DEPED** declared the LCB as post-disqualified due to its failure to comply with the technical specifications, and declared the next lowest calculated bid; **DEPED** post-qualified the next lowest calculated bid and declared the same as post-disqualified due to its failure to comply with the technical specifications, and declared the next lowest calculated bid; **DEPED** post-qualified the aforementioned bid and declared the same as post-disqualified due to its failure to comply with the technical specifications, and declared the bid of **JONECO** as the next lowest calculated bid; **DEPED** post-qualified and declared the bid of **JONECO** as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid for Lot No. 1 in the sum of **PHILIPPINE PESOS EIGHTY-NINE MILLION, NINE HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND and 00/100 (PhP89,964,000.00) ONLY**, (hereinafter called the “Contract Price”) detailed as follows:

NOW THIS CONTRACT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Contract, words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Contract, viz:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBD);
 - i. Invitation to Bid;
 - ii. Instruction to Bidders;
 - iii. Bid Data Sheet;
 - iv. General and Special Conditions of the Contract;
 - v. Schedule of Requirements;
 - vi. Technical Specifications; and
 - vii. Bid Bulletin Nos. 1 and 2 dated December 3, 2022 and January 10, 2023, respectively.
 - b. **JONECO's** bid, including the Eligibility Requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;
 - c. Performance Security;
 - d. Notice of Award of Contract and **JONECO's** conforme thereto; and
 - e. Other contract documents required by existing laws and/or DepEd in the PBD. **JONECO** agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, and Warranty Security, shall form part of the Contract.
3. **JONECO** shall post a Performance Security within 10 calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award in the form and amount prescribed therein. The performance security shall be posted in favor of **DEPED**, and shall be forfeited in the event it is established that **JONECO** is in default of any of its obligations under this contract. **JONECO** shall be responsible for the extension of its performance security and/or undertake to renew its performance security whenever necessary, and without need of prior notice or instruction from the **DEPED**, to ensure that it is in force and effect for the whole duration of the contract and until a Certificate of Final Acceptance is duly issued.
4. The goods referred to in this Contract shall be delivered by **JONECO** to the **Schools Division Offices (SDOs)** within **120 CALENDAR DAYS**, which shall commence within three (3) calendar days, from **JONECO's** receipt of the Notice to Proceed or as may be indicated in the NTP. **JONECO** shall ensure that the goods will be delivered in accordance with the Allocation List, which is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof.

Goods delivered to sites other than the designated SDOs without **DEPED's** written authorization and/or approval may be rejected by the latter.

5. **JONECO** may be required to supervise, maintain, or repair the goods for a period of time as may be agreed by the **PARTIES** provided that such supervision, maintenance, or repair shall not relieve **JONECO** of any warranty obligations under the Contract.
6. Pre-delivery and Pre-implementation Conference shall be conducted prior to the inspection of goods by the designated DepEd Inspectorate Team.
7. **DEPED** shall have the right to visit and inspect **JONECO's** premises covered by the Contract, at any time or stage of contract implementation, to monitor and assess **JONECO's** capacity to discharge its contractual obligations.
8. Prior to and for purposes of inspection, **JONECO** shall ensure convenient access to the goods for inspection. **JONECO** shall assign personnel to undertake the handling, unpacking, assembly, commissioning, disassembly, repacking, resealing, and sorting of the goods prior to, during, and after the inspection. **JONECO** shall inform or notify **DEPED** of said assignment of personnel or any changes thereof.
9. The goods shall be inspected and tested by the designated Inspectorate Team at the SDOs. **JONECO** shall coordinate with **DEPED**, through the Procurement Management Service-Contract Management Division (ProcMS-CMD), on the conduct of inspection or pre-delivery inspection (PDI). Any request for inspection or PDI shall be done in writing, addressed to Atty. Gerard L. Chan, CESO I, Undersecretary for Procurement, and contain the following information:
 - a. Project Title and Contract Number;
 - b. Specific goods for inspection;
 - c. Quantity of goods for inspection;
 - d. Venue/Address of inspection site; and
 - e. Proposed schedule of inspection which must be at least 10 calendar days from the submission of the written request.

10. The goods must conform to and comply with the standards mentioned in Section VI. Schedule of Requirements of the Bidding Documents and must be in accordance with the final technical specifications as approved by the Bids and Awards Committee based on the samples submitted by **JONECO**, and reflected in the post-qualification report, which is hereto attached as Annex "C" and made an integral part hereof.

Any proposal by **JONECO** to deliver goods of different technical specifications, in lieu of those of the approved bids or samples, shall not be allowed. However, under justifiable circumstances, i.e. fortuitous events, force majeure, acts of God, public state emergency, or those defined under the Civil Code and other similar circumstances, delivery of goods of equivalent, higher or superior technical specifications may be permitted, subject to the evaluation and favorable recommendation of the **DEPED's** end-user or implementing unit, and the approval of the herein authorized signatory. In any such case, the proposal by **JONECO** for substitution shall

be in writing. The said proposal shall not result in any additional cost or undue burden to **DEPED**.

11. Goods with defects or non-compliant with the required technical specifications upon delivery shall be rejected, orally or in writing, by **DEPED** and replaced by **JONECO** in accordance with the warranty provisions in the bidding documents. The replacement goods for this reason shall be subject to re-inspection.
12. In case **JONECO** encounters condition(s) impeding timely delivery of the goods, **JONECO** shall promptly notify **DEPED** in writing within five (5) calendar days from notice of such condition(s). Any request for work suspension and/or contract period extension shall be promptly done in writing as soon as circumstances for such request have become apparent. **JONECO** must provide sufficient proof to support any request for work suspension and/or contract period extension.

13. The Contract Price shall be paid to **JONECO** in accordance with the following disbursement procedures:

- a. **JONECO** may submit a request for payment based on progress reports which shall be attached to the progress billing and include the following:
 - i. quantity of goods delivered based on the schedule of delivery and other relevant terms and conditions of the Contract;
 - ii. duly signed Delivery Receipts; and
 - iii. duly signed Inspection and Acceptance Reports (IARs), including certification by **JONECO**, duly signed and dated by the authorized representative of the **DEPED** indicating that the goods have been delivered in accordance with the Contract.

Other documents in support of a request for payment may be required by **DEPED** pursuant to existing disbursement, accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

- b. Payment shall be made to **JONECO** within 60 days from submission of the documents specified in SCC Clause 2.2 and other documents as may be prescribed by **DEPED** in the following manner:
 - i. For the initial progress payment, a minimum of 25% of the Contract Price shall be paid to the **JONECO** upon delivery of at least 25% of the goods and acceptance of the same by **DEPED**'s authorized representative; and
 - ii. Release of retention money shall be at the expiration of the warranty period, or the remaining amount in case it has been utilized pursuant to the warranty provision.

14. Payments shall be subject to the "Warranty" provision in the form of either retention money in an amount equivalent to three percent (3%) of the payment or a Special Bank Guarantee in an amount equal to three percent (3%) of the Contract Price required under Section 62 of R.A. 9184 and its revised IRR. In case **JONECO** opts for retention money, the amount shall only be released after the lapse of the entire warranty period, unless during the remainder of the warranty period, the retention money is substituted with a special bank guarantee.

- a. A three-year warranty for the delivered and accepted laptop units, and one-year warranty for the delivered and accepted laptop batteries, keyboards, laptop headsets, and optical mouse shall reckon from the date of issuance of Certificate of Final Acceptance by **DEPED**.
 - b. **JONECO** shall replace all rejected goods within fifteen (15) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Rejection issued by the concerned SDOs.
15. **JONECO** shall be liable for liquidated damages in an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the delayed goods scheduled for delivery, for every day of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by **DEPED**. **DEPED** shall deduct the liquidated damages from any money due or which may become due to **JONECO**, or collect from any of the securities or warranties posted by **JONECO**, whichever is convenient to **DEPED**. Once the accumulated amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the Contract Price, **DEPED** may rescind or terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.
16. The **PARTIES** shall make every effort to resolve amicably and by mutual consultation any and all disputes or differences arising between the **PARTIES** in connection with the implementation of the Contract. Should such dispute not be resolved amicably, it shall be submitted to Early Neutral Evaluation pursuant to R.A. No. 9285, or the "Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004," and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.
