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2018 CLIMATE SCIENCE YOUTH CAMP OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE
AND TECHNOLOGY-SCIENCE EDUCATION INSTITUTE

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI), in cooperation with the University of the Philippines-Marine Science Institute (UP-MSI) and the Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA), will be conducting the 2018 Climate Science Youth Camp (CYSC) from April 16 to 24, 2018 in San Juan, Siquijor.

The 2018 CYSC is a nine-day activity that aims to:

1. develop the knowledge and skills of participants in the field of oceanography and meteorology through interaction with actual scientists;
2. allow them to explore and experience how these experts perform their work in the field;
3. enable them to use these learnings in their science research subject; and
4. inspire them to pursue Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)-related courses in the future.

Invited participants are two Grade 8 or 9 students of the same gender, and one accompanying science teacher from the following schools:
